Bull Run Winery Tour | 22 July | *Sign-up deadline: 7 July | \$72

Your trip will begin with a scenic 55-minute ride from Joint Base Andrews to Virginia's cozy Bull Run region, the site of the first major battle of the American Civil War. There, you will enjoy an optional walking tour of the Winery at Bull Run's historic grounds before tasting the vineyard's palatable selection of wines. Established in 2012 as a scenic working farm vineyard, The Winery at Bull Run lies on 225 acres adjacent to Manassas National Battlefield Park and next door to an equestrian farm. The winery itself was built to represent the two types of historic barns in Northern Virginia, a smaller 1800's-style barn and a larger 1920's-era dairy barn complete with a hayloft and hay lift cable and beam. The tour will include a 1-hour private wine tasting followed by their Grape to Glass Production tour, where you will experience the full wine production process. You'll tour the vineyard, the crush pad, the state-of-of-the-art Production Barn and into the barrel room where they age the wines. You will also receive a souvenir glass!

Gettysburg, PA Tour | 19 August | *Sign-up deadline: 4 August | \$46

This incredible adventure to Gettysburg begins from Joint Base Andrews in a comfortable, climate-controlled mini-coach. We'll make the 2-hour drive to the battlefield fly by with informative stories on the background of the battle. Fought in 1863, the conflict saw confederate and union soldiers clash in a brutal feud lasting three full days. The battle resulted in around 51,000 casualties, more than any other domestic battle in USA history, and proved a significant turning point in the American Civil War. Upon arrival at the infamous Gettysburg grasslands, you'll be able to stretch your legs with 5 hours of activities, including a guided tour of the battlefield, Visitor Center Museum, and significant monuments such as the Lee and Mead Statues, Peace Memorial, and Eternal Flame. You'll also get a glimpse of the old Colonial Town Center of Gettysburg, along with insight on what life was like for regular folk back then.

Luray Caverns Tour | 16 September | *Sign-up deadline: 1 September | \$64

An adrenaline-pumping adventure awaits on this tour from Joint Base Andrews to Luray Caverns, with round-trip transport in a luxurious private vehicle! Make like Indiana Jones with an expedition to the atmospheric caves of the Shenandoah Mountains. Combining natural beauty and fascinating history in equal measure, this sensational tour is great fun for all the family. You'll be collected from your DC address in one of our comfortable, climate-controlled vehicles, before journeying through epic vistas to reach Luray, Virginia. Here, you'll embark on a guided one-hour tour of the caverns, with a network of 63 acres to explore. Afterward, you'll have around three hours of free time to partake in a range of activities, from tackling the nerve-wracking ropes course to absorbing geology knowledge at the Gem Sluice experience. You'll also find the Car & Carriage Caravan Museum and the Shenandoah Heritage Village to occupy your time. Lunch at the property is included, and you'll be given the flexibility to explore at a pace that suits you!

Annapolis, MD Tour | 7 October | *Sign-up deadline: 22 September | \$37

Only 45 minutes from our nation's capitol is one of America's most historic cities, the Maryland State Capitol of Annapolis. The home of the United States Naval Academy, a central point of the American Revolution, and the city once called the "Athens of America", Annapolis was settled in 1649 by Puritan exiles from Virginia. The community had a series of names, including Providence and Anne Arundel Town, until finally named Annapolis in 1694 in honor of Princess Anne of England. Annapolis' fantastic location along the world-famous Chesapeake Bay has been enabled to be a prime location for fishing and boating. While you are here, enjoy some tasty Maryland crab for lunch at one of the many amazing dockside restaurants! After learning the colonial history of the area via a walking tour, we'll go into the Naval Academy for an exclusive tour behind the scene with trained military tour guides!
