COLLECTION

Joint Base Andrews Library has a vast and varied collection of books, audiobooks, DVDs, video games, board games, Launchpad Learning Tablets, and more.

Of particular note are our Professional Reading, EFMP, and Study Guide sections.

COMPUTER ACCESS

Our computer room is equipped with CAC-enabled computers with pay-to-print access (10 cents per page, cash only), along with a copier, scanner and fax.

We provide access to Navy Knowledge Online (NKO), Army Knowledge Online (AKO), Air Force Reserve Orders Writing System (AROWS-R), Air National Guard (ANG), and Air Force portals.

2. WHY DOES THE COMPUTER ROOM CLOSE BEFORE THE LIBRARY?

We close the computer lab 30 minutes before the library to allow library staff time to protect the safety and security of our patrons.

It's likely we can borrow that item for you from a partner library through the Interlibrary Loan program. Also, help us grow our collection by suggesting the title. Talk to library staff about an ILL and requesting an item for our collection other patrons will like.

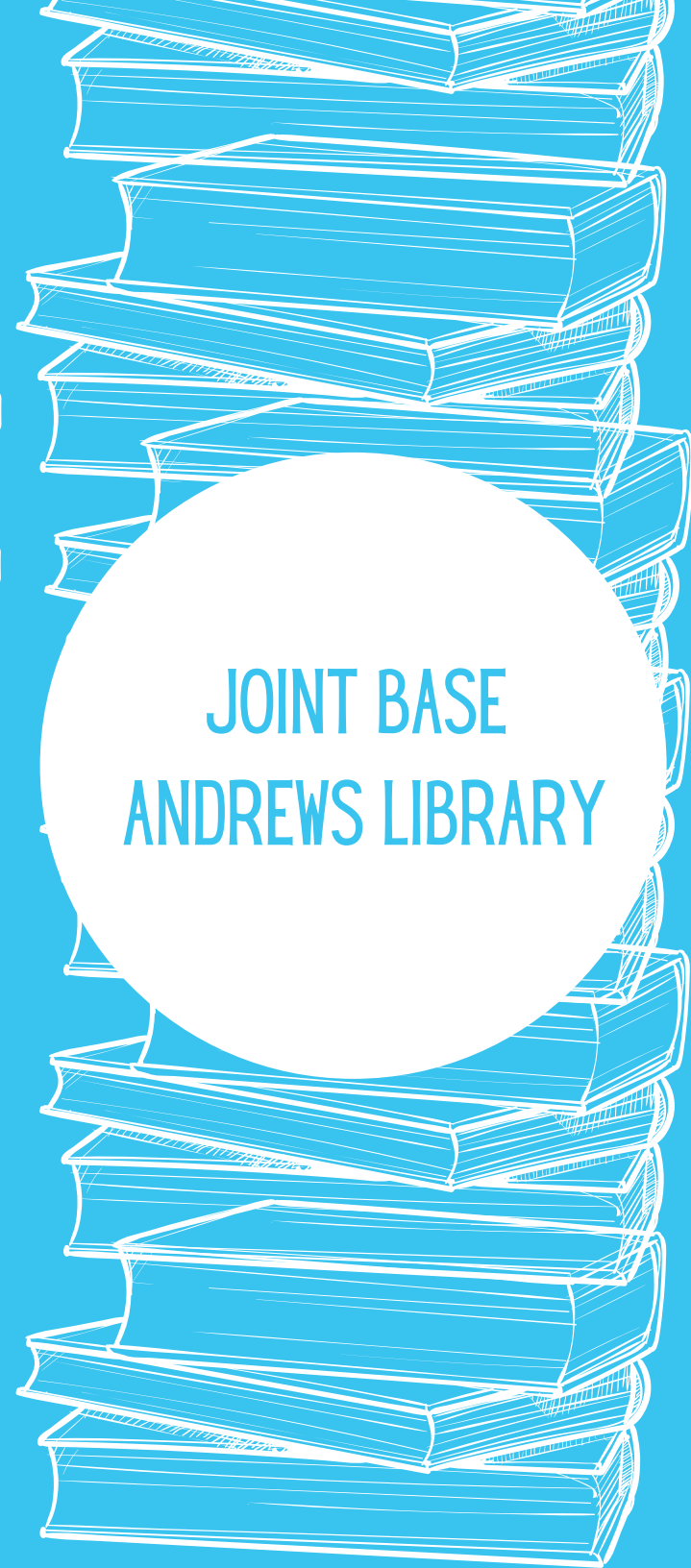
